Site Information

Reception 08:00 to 21:00 except for emergencies. Local information, games, DVD's, books - available to borrow.

Arrival/Depature Arrival between 4pm and 9pm. Vacate the site by 10am.

Communication Phones There is a payphone located in reception with useful and emergency contact details.

WIFI Available at a small charge payable on connection to 'Bunroy Park' network.

Water Fresh, Scottish water is available out of the taps marked as drinking water!

LaundryWashing and drying machines are located in the shower block; please refer to the map for details. **Rubbish**The location of bins is shown on the sitemap. Please use the correct bin and help us recycle. Glass

cannot be recycled on site - please recycle glass at Darwin's Rest recycling point in the village.

Wildlife We ask that you be respectful to the local wildlife. Human food can be detrimental to their health.

Fishing You may fish at the bottom of the Park on the River Spean.

Fridge and freezer for campers' use in the laundry room. Please make sure you name is on food items

in the fridge. All items not named will be discarded.

Calor/Camping Gas These may be obtained from reception during normal office hours.

Shower block Cleaned daily and checked regularly. Please let us know if anything needs our attention.

Evacuation Plan Please make yourself familiar with our evacuation point in case of any unforeseen emergency. In case of

emergency, please remain calm and follow instruction from staff.

Park Policies

Speed Limit The site speed limit is **10 mph** for the safety of all.

Litter Keep the scene clean!

Fires No open fires are allowed on the ground anywhere on the site, including the river bank.

Barbeques No barbeques directly on the grass – please ensure that your barbeque or unshielded gas burner is

raised 6" to avoid scorching the grass. Do not put hot coal in the bins. Please note that hot cooking

pans also kill the grass! Never leave a fire unattended.

REMEMBER CARBON MONOXIDE KILLS! NEVER USE A BARBEQUE IN YOUR TENT OR AWNING.

NoiseTo be kept at a modest and reasonable level at all times and to an <u>absolute minimum</u>

between 10:00pm and 08:00am. If someone else's noise is disturbing you, please let us know.

Dogs Welcome but must be kept on a lead at all times and must not be allowed to foul the site. There are

walks through the woodland and along the riverbank to exercise them.

Ground sheets Please lift your ground sheets regularly to avoid killing the grass.

Ball games If playing ball games please ensure that you don't disturb other guests or damage their property. **Children** Children should be supervised by a responsible adult at all times. Please ensure that children are aware

of the dangers of the roads and the river.

Fish No cleaning or gutting of fish using Park facilities.

Bicycles: Bicycles may be ridden in the park with care and consideration to others. It is the parent's responsibility

to ensure their children wear helmets in the park when riding their bikes. Unregistered motor vehicles

are not permitted in the Park at any time except for disability use.

Accommodation Please leave lodges/pods clean and tidy. Accommodation left in an unreasonable condition or

damaged will incur an additional charge. Our lodges/pods are all Smoke-Free and will incur and

additional cleaning charge if smoking odours are detected.

Evictions The Park reserves the right to evict anyone who makes or created a problem in the Park, giving the said

person or persons one (1) hour to vacate their site/lodge/pod/pitch.

Insurance The owner takes no responsibility for any loss/damage/injury/expense to belongings or persons

however caused whilst on the park. Please ensure you are adequately insured.
