## GATE HOUSE WOOD TOURING PARK

Here is some information to help you while staying at Gate House Wood.

The opening times for the shop are displayed in the shop window. During the peak season we offer



fresh Bread,Demi Baguettes,Croissants,Pain au Chocolait & Pain au Raisin also newspapers, all these need to be ordered the previous day.

In the shop there are local farm meats; burgers – beef/lamb and chicken, Sausages – Cumberland/Hop/Pork & Apple/Beef and other BBQ meats.



Fresh farm eggs, bread and milk. Also available a selection of other groceries, toys, sweets and ice cream, as well as a small selection of camping

equipment. Please feel free to pop in and browse.

- All day Visitors must register and pay at Reception
- .£1 per adult 50p per child.
- We ask that all visitors leave the park quietly by 10 o'clock

When the gates are closed.

- On day of departure please vacate the pitch at 11.30am.
- Late stay possible for a small charge if your pitch is available, please check with Reception.



The shower block is closed daily for cleaning at 11o'clock – 1pm. There are other toilets available next to the reception/shop.

•We ask that an adult accompanies young children to the toilets.

- The washing of cars and caravans is not permitted.
- There is a 5mph speed limit around the park. Please watch out for children!.



The barriers lock at 11pm, returning later will

mean parking in the car park and quietly walking back to your unit. Thank you.

There is a one way system that operates around the site, and you will need a barrier key to enter and exit.



There are 3 rubbish points on the park, 1. at the shower block and 1 each end of the park. Please collapse plastic bottles and leave lids off so the rubbish can be crushed.

Sorry but we cannot take broken household/camping items, chairs etc,

Please take home or use our local tip at Tovil. We thank you for your co-operation. Barbecues are allowed, as long as they are of the ground.

Bricks can be found by the dustbins, please return when finished with, thank you.

A metal bin for BBQ ash is at the shower block waste point. Please ensure the ashes are NOT alight!

Due to a bye law of the site license, OPEN FIRES AND BURNING OF WOOD IS STRICTLY NOT ALLOWED.

Sorry but here are some do's & don'ts ! With your parents' permission you Can make Camps in the woods. Use the old wood that you find on the ground, also the bracken. Do not pull branches off the trees, please let them grow! Have fun and keep safe!



The use of soft foam balls on site is allowed, although football games depend on the space available. Please be aware of

other Campers, do not invade their space.

Water games are NOT allowed. This includes paddling pools. Conserving water.

Please keep bikes and scooters off the pathway to the showers and shop. We don't want anyone tripping over them! Cycle safely round the park...remember 5 mph limited!!
