Park Facilities & Rules

Reception & Shop

Open 9am – 5pm every day.
Fridays open until 7pm.

The shop is stocked with a selection of camping equipment, gas bottles, toiletries, toys, snacks, ice creams, and cold drinks. Our tourist information point is also located at the reception.

Car Park & Gates

The gates are locked between 10.30 – 7am. Vehicles arriving between these times should park in the car park.

Late Arrivals

In case of an emergency or late arrival, please call 01435 813662 and your call will be diverted to a member of staff.

Pitches

Occupation

Please check with the site before you arrive that there's a suitable pitch available for large or heavy vehicles.

Vacating

Pitches are to be vacated by 12 noon, however, if you wish to stay a bit longer, please check for availability at the reception.

Water & Chemical Waste

Drinking water taps and chemical toilet flushes are situated around Horam Manor Country Park and are indicated on the map.

Recycling & Water

Bins are provided for the disposal of your rubbish and can be found on the map. Littering on the park and surroundings will not be tolerated. Large items of rubbish must be disposed of off site.

Toilet/Showers/ Disabled/ Family Room

There are two toilet/shower blocks, one in each field. A code is needed to access the facilities, and the disabled facility and family room requires a key (£5 refundable deposit). Both are available at the reception.

Laundry

Washing and drying facilities are available at Horam Manor and are located at the top field.

Prices are £3 per washing machine load and £1 per tumble dryer. There is also an ironing board available and irons can be hired at £5 returnable deposit. There are washing-up sinks in both toilet blocks. Please do not hang washing lines between trees or fences.

Electric Hook-up

Where available, 10amp and 16amp hook-ups are included in the price.

TV Reception

The TV reception is very good and available on most pitches across Horam Manor Country Park.

WIFI/Telephones

We offer free WIFI across the entire park. Look for "Freedom Hotspot", a Self-registration is needed. There is limited reception on Vodafone and O2 networks.

Children

Parents are reminded that children are supervised by an adult and remain their responsibility at all times. Children must not be left unattended when in the play park.

BBQ's

We are happy for you to enjoy a BBQ. Please ensure that this is raised off the ground – bricks are provided in the bin points. Hot ashes should be disposed of in the Ash Bins located outside the bin points. BBQs must be lit in safe areas, away from children playing. DO NOT light BBQs or stoves inside tents or caravans. Campfires and Fire Pits are not permitted on the park.

Fire Points & Regulations

In the event of a fire, extinguishers and alarm points are indicated on the park map. Fire Assembly point is at the reception car park. To comply with the Fire Regulations please leave at least 1.5m between the edge of the pitch & your unit. Cars must be parked on your pitch and not in the car park.

Dogs

Are allowed but must be kept on a lead at all times. Dog Walking is on the Recreation Field. All fouling must be cleaned up by the person responsible for the dog. Dogs must not be left unattended.

Visitors

All visitors must report to reception before entering the park. Only one car per pitch is allowed. Please park on the pitch you are visiting. Charges per day: Adults £2, Child (5+) £1, Car £3. All visitors should leave the park by 10.30pm.

Noise Levels

This is a family park, so please respect other guests and keep noise to a minimum. No noise is allowed between 10.30pm and 7am.

Safety while on site

Entry Gates

Gates will be locked between 10.30pm and 7am.

CCTV

Cameras are in operation at key locations around the park for your own safety.

Driving, Cycling & Skating around the Park

Motor vehicles must keep within the speed limit of 5mph. All visitors should be aware that children may be playing throughout the park. Bicycles, scooters, and skate equipment are allowed on the park, however, please consider that speeding, and riding around the amenity block or other people's pitches is forbidden. Motorised scooters, motorised bicycles and quad bikes are not permitted. Motorised mobility scooters are permitted on the park.

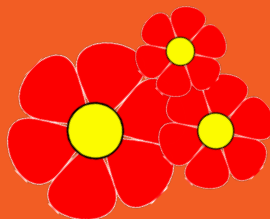


