

Taunton is the historic County Town of Somerset. A wealth of historic detail and tradition abounds. The Castle and the museum are both sights to behold. Cornish Farm is easily reached from any direction being approximately 2 miles from Taunton town centre. Although not on a bus route, two thirds of the journey can be covered by bus. A cycle path and footpath will take you into the heart of the town on a mainly level, mostly dedicated off road path.

The site is level, and well drained. There is subtle lighting (low energy) dusk to dawn street and pitch lights. Numerous 220 volt, fire and water points for your convenience. Black water and grey water disposal is sensibly located in the middle of the site and is easily accessed with a drive over grey water dump suitable for both caravans and motorhomes.



Excellent facilities. Our fully tiled shower and wash rooms, which have the added luxury of under-floor heating to keep you warm, will ensure that you can use the facilities any time of year.

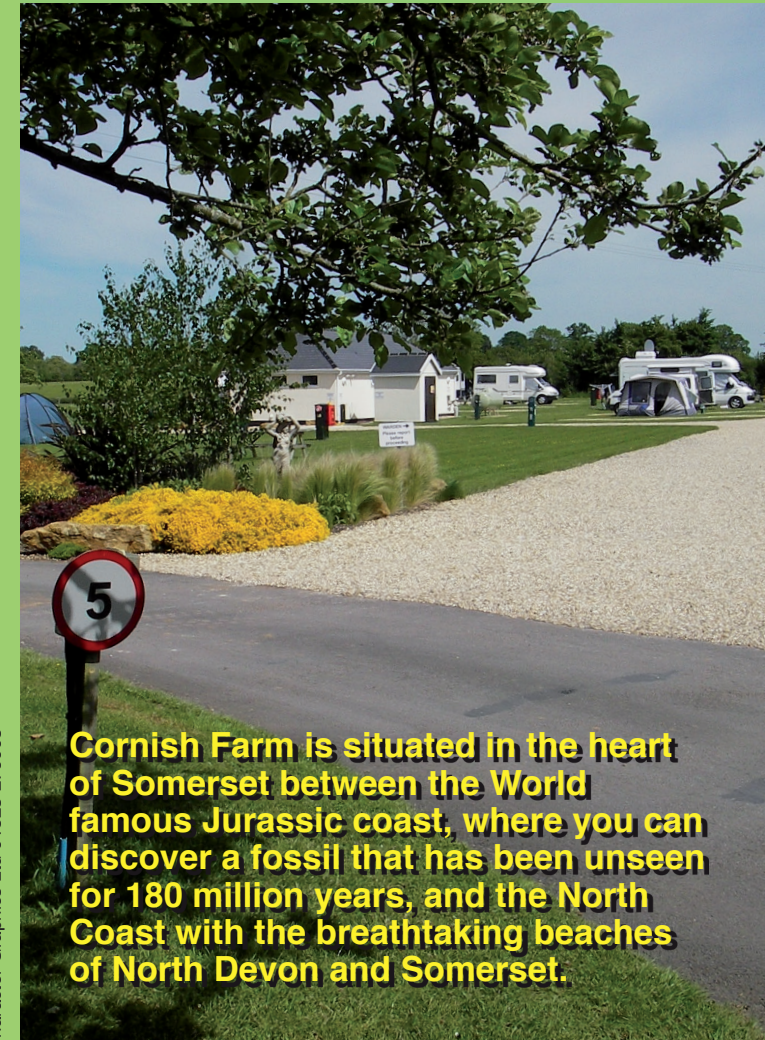


LAUNDRY AND DRYING

Our large level gravelled hard standings are well drained and clean. Each hard standing has a dedicated 220volt electric hook-up point (each with its' own trip switch which is accessible to the user). Each hard standing is within easy reach of water points and fire points.

All our grass pitches are level and in easy reach of a dedicated 220volt electric hook-up point (each with its own trip switch which is accessible to the user). Each grass pitch is within easy reach of water points and fire points. Separate car parking (off grass) is available for those that require it at no extra charge, by arrangement with the warden (limited availability)



HOW TO FIND US

M5 Junction 25 follow the signs for Taunton. At the first set of traffic lights at Creech Castle turn left signposted Corfe B3170. Take 3rd left (at traffic lights) into Ilminster Road again following the signs Corfe. Bear right at roundabout onto Blackbrook Way. Bear left at next roundabout and follow the road to the end 'T' junction which is the B3170. Turn right and then take the next left into Killams Drive. Take the 2nd left into Killams Avenue and follow the road, passing housing estate and finally over the motorway bridge. Cornish Farm is immediately after the motorway bridge on the left hand side. Ignore the first entrance to the main house and buildings, proceed to the second entrance which is a little further along the road. Alternatively, from the TOWN CENTRE, take the B3170 (opposite Sainsbury's) signposted Corfe. Straight through a set of traffic lights, passing 'One Stop' shop (on the right) take the 3rd right into Killams Drive. Follow route as above.

OR: Follow brown signs towards Taunton Racecourse until you see the brown campsite signs. These signs start at about 3/4 mile from Cornish Farm Touring Park.
