The Park is divided into glades, Cherry, Oak, Holly, Apple, Maple, Beech, Birch and Willow if you look closely you may see these trees around the glades.

There are many places of interest in the surrounding area including Drago Castle, Rosemoor Gardens and Dartmoor National Park for more places to visit please look in our information room, on our website or ask Tim & Rebecca.

If you like walking there are a number of routes in the area just ask. For those with bikes, we are less than a mile for National Cycle Route 27, which is part of the Devon Coast to Coast route. We are also a short distance from the Granite Way.

If you require any more ideas please ask we are always willing to help, but also if you find something that other people might appreciate in please let us know so that we might pass it on.

Getting to know your site.

The site operates a one way system, please observe the signage, and keep to the 5 mile an hour speed limit. Also please do not walk through the hedges.

Information Room

This is located at the toilet block and is open at all times. Leaflets are available for local attractions and places of interest that you can visit during your stay. There is also a folder containing menus from the pubs and restaurants in the area. A map on the wall gives an idea of distances for many of the attractions. Eggs are also available.

Mobile & emergency telephones, Wi Fi

There is variable mobile signal around the site so once you find signal don't move! A telephone for emergences is available at the Wardens house .Wi Fi coverage is free across the park, the login password is... **Appledore20.** Please don't forget you are in the countryside so speeds maybe slower.

Vacating your pitch

Pitches are to be vacated by 12 noon on day of departure. If you wish to stay past 12 please ask as we can often accommodate.

Barbecues

Are allowed but <u>must be kept clear of the grass</u>, bricks can be found in the information room, please return them when you have finished. Please remember anything hot will kill the grass. A fire pit is available away from the camping areas for your enjoyment, please ask the wardens for details. Alternatively a brazier can be hired. Logs and charcoal are available for sale here or can be purchased at the local filling stations.

Reception Services

The reception building is not attended during off peak hours. Please ask the wardens should you require gas etc. If we're not on the park we can be called upon at our house adjacent .

TV reception

The Torrington transmitter is to the north of the park. See map overleaf for aerial orientation .

Electric Hook-ups and Water point

The cost of electricity is included in you pitch fee, but please help us to minimise our effect on the environment by considering your electricity use while on site. Electric awning heaters are not allowed. Each bollard has a water point, you may connect a hose to this to filling water barrels and on board tanks, but when you have finished please disconnect. These are not super pitches.

Toilets and showers

The toilets are closed for cleaning for a short time each day. The disabled toilet and shower facilities may be used at those times. We are not on the main sewerage system, we have our own waste water treatment plant. Because of this please do not dispose of nappies, wet/face wipes in the toilets, use only the toilet paper provided. The showers are operated by movement sensors, so be careful not to get wet before you are ready.

Washing facilities

We do not have any washing facilities. There is a laundrette in Station Road, Okehampton. Opening times in the information room.

Pets

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times on the pitching areas and roads within the site, and clean up <u>after them.</u> There is a dog walk on site, where dogs may be let of the lead, please clean up after them, with dog waste bins conveniently placed.

Fire Point

(to activate alarm/warning) Located on the service points around the site. The fire assembly point is located opposite reception.

Children

Parents are reminded that children remain their responsibility and therefore they should be supervised appropriately and ensure that all members of their party follow the principles of road safety. Please ensure your children are not an annoyance to other visitors. Ball games are allowed but away from the pitch areas, toilet block and other peoples units.

The Lake and wildlife

We have a lake on site which is stocked with carp. These can be fished, although we do charge a small fee for your whole stay. When around the lake please be careful of your personal safety, the lake is not suitable for swimming. If you happen to see wildlife around the park, we are collecting sightings in our wildlife book which can be found in the information room. Please tell us what you see.

Waste and Recycling Facilities

Please help us reduce the waste going to land fill by recycling waste We have mixed recycling (paper, tins and plastic bottles) and glass recycling. Other materials can be recycled at the Waitrose car park in Okehampton and at the council recycling centre please ask the Warden for directions.

Shopping and cash machines

There are supermarkets (Co-op, Waitrose and Lidl) in Okehampton and a 24 hour store at the BP Station by the A30. The nearest free cash machine is at the BP Station, with bank machines in Okehampton. Eggs and homemade dog biscuits are available in the information room or ask the wardens,
