INTO THE WOODS

You will see a note on the tree and a piece of orange twine attached to it, follow the twine and bears you should find!

DEN BUILDING you'll find over the far side of the woods and is pretty self explanatory.

CAFE MUD is brand new this year and we are so excited! The mud kitchen is a fully enclosed area complete with seating, a mud kitchen and all pots and pans needed to cook up a mucky feast! Please ensure children keep all equipment within the designated cafe area and ensure the gate stays closed so that the cows don't move in. Many thanks.

ON ARRIVAL

Once you've turned off the road into the farm you'll soon see a sign on your left pointing you into the campsite. Feel free to let yourself into the field and pick your favourite spot, then send us a message to let us know you've arrived and which pitch you're on.

SAFETY FIRST!

As this is a working and very busy farm we do ask that our campers stick to the campsite and the wood to the side of the camp and stay clear of the drive down to the farm if it can be helped. Your safety is important to us and we know just how dangerous farms can be. If you need us we should always be contactable by phone but if you do need to come down to the house please bare in mind that there is a lot of machinery up and down so be careful.

The wood can be accessed via the stile which can be found on the far side of camp but again comes with a warning - We can have cattle grazing the field the other side of the wood and they do also have access to the wood so we ask you to stay vigilant, keep your dogs on leads at all times and of course pick up after them too. One of our two bulls is in with this bunch of cattle and so take extra care if choosing to walk in the woods. The bull is named Mighty, if you catch a glimpse he's sure to impress... He's a good looking chap!

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE



- Fridays are a bit of a busy one for us in the summer as our children are at cricket club, this means that if you are arriving on a Friday there will be nobody on camp until a little later. This however shouldn't be an issue, just pick your pitch and start relaxing, we will pop in to say hi on our way home and take any payments. We will leave the fire pits out for anyone who would like to hire one (£5pn). You can grab one from outside the bell tent next to the camp gate and we will collect payment on our return.
- We are a LEAVE NO TRACE site. That means that we don't have bins (except the dog waste bin by the gate and the cold ash bins by the shed). Please be aware of this and plan accordingly.
- If camping with children please ensure you give them a run down on how to use the compost loos, in particular the sawdust, and how much.

One handful is enough after a number two. A number one doesn't require any.

- The campsite and woods are for the use of campers. All other fields are private property and we ask that you don't wander.
- We don't allocate pitches and so you are free to pick your favourite spot but please send us a whatsapp message once you've chosen and let us know the number you are on.
- Wood is available to collect from The Watering Hole and is an honesty system, Please leave £6 cash in the tin or pay via the QR code on the wall.
- CASH IS KING - Cash is our preferred method of payment. As a small business we get charged for every transaction. By paying cash we retain 100% of its value. Please support small businesses by paying cash where possible.
